## Glasgow Leadership Lecture

The Right Honourable Lord Patten of Barnes, CH

Monday 1 March 2010



The Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Glasgow is pleased to welcome the Right Honourable Lord Patten of Barnes, as the fourth Guest Lecturer on Leadership.

**Lord Patten of Barnes** was elected to parliament in 1979 and held his seat in Bath until April 1992. During that time he became a cabinet minister and party chairman of the Conservative Government. In his latter capacity, he orchestrated the Conservatives' unexpected fourth consecutive electoral victory in 1992 but lost his own seat in the House of Commons. He then accepted the post of Governor and Commander-in-Chief of Hong Kong, and oversaw its return to China in July 1997. In 1999 he was appointed Chairman of the Independent Commission on Policing in Northern Ireland and European Commissioner for External Relations. From 2000 to 2004 he served as one of Britain's two members of the European Commission. After leaving that post, he returned to the UK and was elevated to peerage in 2005. A critically acclaimed political writer; he is currently the Chancellor of the University of Oxford, and an international keynote speaker and advisor to a number of companies.
