



**Intercollegiate MRCS Part 2 Written Examination- GLASGOW
Wednesday 1st September 2010**

The examination will be held in **The Royal College of Physicians & Surgeons of Glasgow**, 232-242 St Vincent Street, Glasgow, G2 5RJ from **14:00 – 17:00 hrs.** Candidates should report to the College **no later than 13: 30 hrs.**

Candidates must bring photographic ID with them in the form of a current passport, driving licence, hospital ID card or equivalent documentation.

The results of the examination, in *Personal ID Number* order, will be posted on the College web site normally 3-4 weeks after the examination takes place. Results letters will be posted approximately one week later..

Note: Any candidate who has taken the Part 2 examination for the first time in April 2007 and who has not passed all three parts of the examination by the conclusion of the oral/clinical diet to be held in October/November 2010 will have no further opportunity to sit the examination in the UK and will be time-expired. There may be exceptional circumstances in which a longer period may be allowed, but these circumstances will be evaluated on an individual basis after submission of appropriate evidence by the candidate in question.

It is anticipated that the IMRCS examination will continue to be available at overseas centres after 2010.
