ISFE: End of Transitional Arrangements

The transitional arrangements that were in place during 2021/2022 to allow for candidates to switch over to the new ISFE Examination format have now come to an end. This means that going forward all candidates;

- Candidates must normally pass Part A within two years of their first attempt at Part A
- Candidates must pass Part A before applying to sit Part B
- Candidates must normally pass Part B by the end of their training programme, or within two years of their first attempt at Part B
- Candidates will have a maximum of four attempts at Part A and four attempts at Part B
