- 8. What is the appraisal process and what does it involve?
- 9. What domains are involved in the appraisal process? Give examples of the type of information you would input in each domain.
- 10. What other components are discussed at appraisal (if not mentioned above)?
- 11. What are the benefits of appraisal and what are the problems that could result?
