Maternity, paternity and parental leave	Members are exempt from payment of subscription fees for the duration of their maternity/paternity/parental leave
Return to full-time education	Members are exempt from payment of subscription fee for the duration of their return to full-time education
Retired	A reduced fee is available - please <u>click here</u> for retired rates
Less than full time working	Discounts will be determined by full-time equivalence e.g. 0.8FTE will be expected to pay 80% of fees.
